PARTICIPANTS

Active

Active participants are professional singers of various ages and promising students who are working toward the goal of becoming professional performers. The active participants are divided into two levels:

Advanced

The advanced singers participate in master classes. They receive individual coachings with international faculty which includes various language instruction and performance opportunities. Space is limited to ensure personal attention.

Intermediate

The intermediate singers observe all and participate in several master classes. They receive private lessons, individual coachings, various language instruction and performance opportunities according to their repertory and level of development. Space is limited to ensure personal attention.

Auditor

The auditors observe all master classes and participate in program activities. Singers, voice teachers, coaches, conductors and choral singers are welcome. This category is also ideal for lovers of music wishing to experience the development of young artists and enjoy Tuscany with all it has to offer.

WEEKLY CURRICULUM

Singers should arrive in Greve prepared with arias and art songs they wish to perfect.

Master Classes

The Daniel Ferro Vocal Program centers on the time-tested medium of the Master Class, where the instructor works with each singer on a rotating basis. Those observing learn by example and can relate new concepts of technique and interpretation to their own preparation. Over the years many legendary teachers of the nineteenth and early twentieth centuries have imparted their wisdom in this setting.

Master Classes constitute the core of the program and provide intensive study of vocal technique as applied to the literature. Master Classes are led by members of the faculty and invited Guest Artists.

Private Lessons

In addition to frequent individual work in the master classes, active participants are scheduled for private lessons with faculty members and Guest Artists.

Coaching Sessions

Individual coachings are scheduled for all active participants, focusing on musical preparation with respect to style, tradition and accuracy of presentation.

Workshops

Members of our international faculty will present master classes devoted to the repertoire in a particular linguistic tradition or area of interest. Singers will participate at the discretion of the faculty.

Performances

Active singers may have the opportunity to perform, at the discretion of the faculty, in one or more public recitals in Greve and the surrounding region.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The application deadline is March 1, 2025.

Applicants should be prepared to present at least three recently recorded selections (songs and/or arias) which best displays their vocal and musical capabilities. Applicants can submit emailed links (video and/or audio links, YouTube links, or mp3 email attachments) in the body of an email.

Each applicant must submit the following:

- 1. \$50 non-refundable application fee, to be paid through PayPal, bank transfer, or check. Checks are to be made payable to the Daniel Ferro Vocal Program, Inc., in US Dollars (US\$)
- 2. Complete application form
- 3. Photograph
- 4. Résumé (detailing educational experience, operatic and recital background and performance history)
- 5. Repertoire list, including current song, opera and oratorio material, as well as music for future study
- 6. Letter of recommendation from an established musician for applicants who have not previously attended
- 7. Performance Videos (at least three) should include opera, song literature and/or oratorio in one or more languages.
